

IMPORTANT EVENTS OF TELANGANA STATE JUDICIAL ACADEMY
BETWEEN 01.07.2024 TO 30.09.2024

Brief Outline of trainings, programs, workshop and events conducted at TSJA:

The Telangana State Judicial Academy has conducted various programmes and workshops between 01.07.2024 to 30.09.2024. The Programmes during the period inter-alia include ongoing III Foundation Course Spell-I in-house training for 3 newly appointed District and Sessions Judges besides visit to District courts of Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Malkajgiri, and Rangareddy at LB Nagar as part of practical training, ongoing IV Basic Course Spell-I in-house training for 7 newly appointed Junior Civil Judges besides visit to District court Ranga Reddy at Lb Nagar as part of practical training, II Basic Course-Final Reflective and Integrated Learning in-house for 39 Junior Civil Judges, III Basic Course – Institutional Training (Phase-2) in-house for 36 Junior Civil Judges.

Training and Events:

The Academy had organized 3 day Training Programme in collaboration with SAMVAD-NIMHANS(Support,Advocacy & Mental health interventions for children in Vulnerable circumstances And Distress(A National Initiative & Integrated Resource for Child Protection, Mental Health, & Psychosocial Care) on '**Legal, Psychosocial & Mental Health Consideration**' for Principal. Magistrates of Juvenile Justice Boards and trainee Judicial Officers of the Academy from **18.07.2024 to 20.07.2024**. The Guest Speakers were Sri Subham Krishna Borah, Project Officer (Policy & Law), and Ms. Kriti Tikku, Project Officer(Mental Health) from SAMAVAD-NIMHANS, Bengaluru.

Academy had convened Judicial Colloquium on **Anti Human Trafficking for several stake holders** viz. Judicial Officers, Public Prosecutors, Police Officers, NGOs on 27-07-2024 in coordination with Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India New Delhi, inaugurated by chief guest Hon'ble Sri Justice P Sam Koshy, Judge, High Court for State of Telangana and President Telangana State Judicial Academy in the august presence of Hon'ble Smt Justice P.Sree Sudha, Judge, High Court for the State of Telangana.
